Subject: Procedure to replace voltage regulator



Step by step procedure on how to replace voltage regulator.

Step 1:

Remove rear cover mounting screws
and terminal hardware (Fig 1)
Remove rear cover.

Note: Keep all hardware removed in this step
as these will be reused.

Step 2:

Remove hardware attaching regulator to the
alternator. (Fig 2)
Remove regulator.

Fig 3. Shows regulator removed.

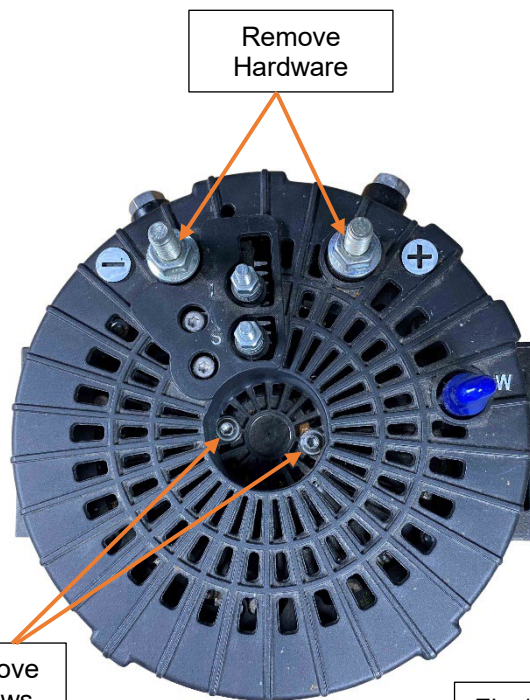

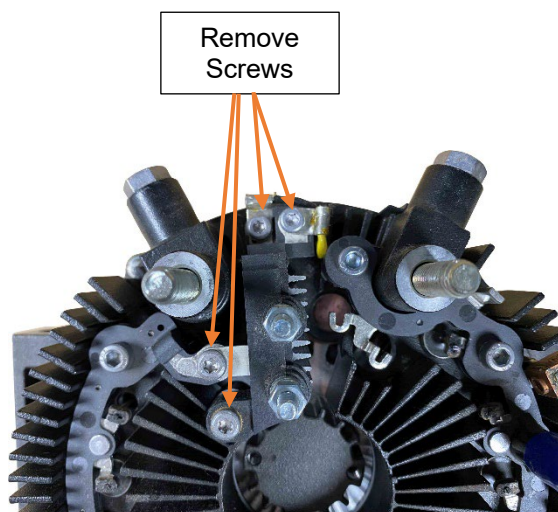

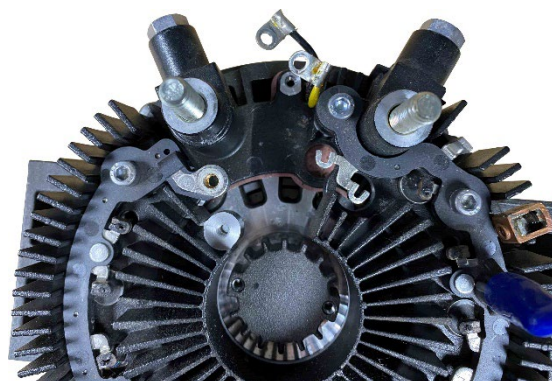

Step 4:
Install replacement regulator and install mounting screws. (Fig 4)
Torque screws to 2–2.5 Nm.

Step 5:
Install rear cover
Torque 2 M4X12 rear cover mounting screws to 2 – 2.5 Nm. (Fig 5)

Step 6:
Install 2 M8 flange nuts. (Fig 5)

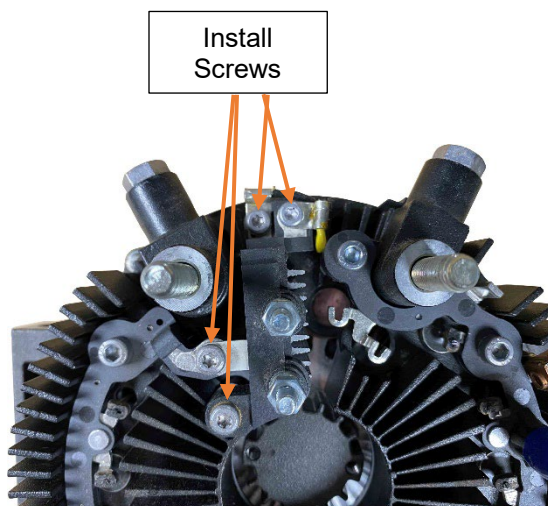

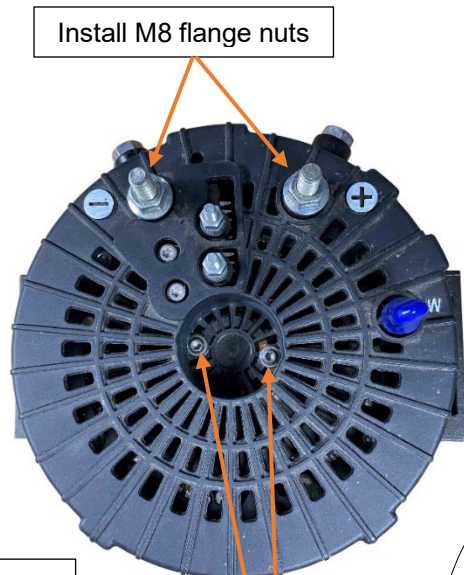
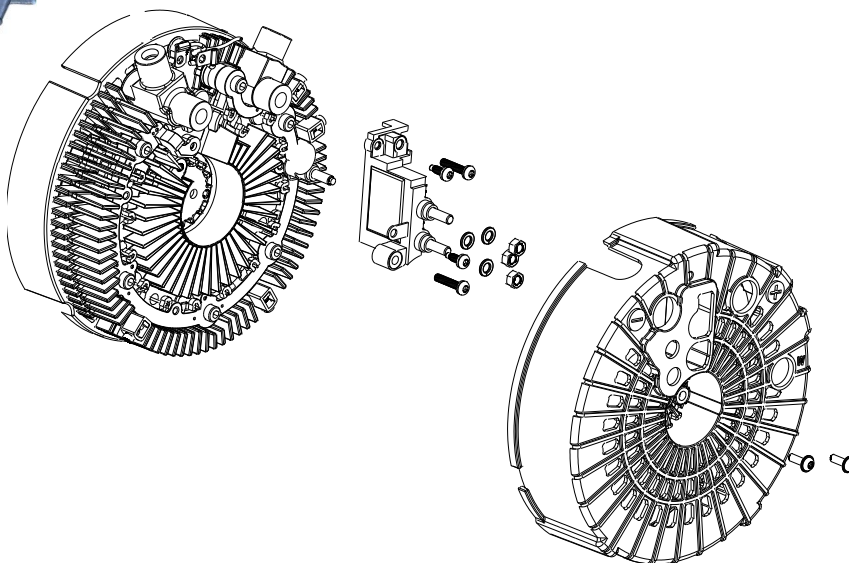
